Harris County Continues Work in Freeport-Cloverleaf Area

CLOVERLEAF, Texas - Commissioner Jack Morman continues improvements as the Cloverleaf road reconstruction project advances to phase two. Commissioner's Court authorized contractors to begin construction on various roads in the Cloverleaf area with a construction value of \$3.8 million. The street project was funded by federal grants targeting areas damaged by Hurricane Ike. The project includes nearly 10 miles of road reconstruction and will vastly improve driving conditions.

“We have focused on roadway and drainage improvements in the Cloverleaf and Freeport area for quite some time. I’m excited to see this phase of reconstruction underway,” said Harris County Commissioner Jack Morman.

Construction activities began on Monday, October 5th along Manor Street between I-10 and just north of Alderson Street, and will be followed by 8 additional roads. This project is expected to be complete by early third quarter of 2016.
